CHAMPAGNE

1. Laurent-Perrier La Cuvee Brut,

Champagne, France V/VG

Redolent with orchard and stone fruits. The palate is peachy and creamy with notes of white fruits and summer flowers.

2. Laurent-Perrier Cuvee

Rosé Brut NV,

Champagne, France V/VG

The original rosé Champagne. Redcurrants, strawberries and red plum mix with aromas of toast and warm herbs. The palate is rich yet elegant with raspberry jus, mint and morello cherries. The mousse is finely structured and adds a touch of honeyed texture.

3. Bollinger Special Cuvee,

Champagne, France

Expect nothing less than excellence in every sip. Rich. Ripe. Powerful. These velvety complex bubbles have aromas of roasted apple, walnut and spice, with flavours of pear, biscuit and toasted brioche.

4. Laurent Perrier Blanc De Blancs,

Champagne, France V/VG

Fine toasted nuts, Manua honey, ripe yet understated tropical fruit, and some spritzzy lemon, characterise this elegant and expressive Champagne. The palate is crisp, precise and has a core of mineral like acidity. Add in exotic spices, fine yellow fruits and summer flowers, and you're getting somewhere near it.

5. Dom Perignon Cuvee,

Champagne, France

Perhaps the world's most famous wine, Dom Pérignon defies easy description. Complex and elegant notes of nuts, peaches, aromatic spices and toast all mingle with caramel, orchard fruits and savoury, bready notes. It's long, concentrated and exceptionally generous.

SPARKLING

6. Dimora Prosecco,

Veneto, Italy V/VG

Crisp green apples and conference pears sit alongside nectarine and blossom notes. The palate is fine and elegant with a touch of mineral and peach stone.

7. Tosti Prosecco Rosé Millesimato,

Piemonte, Italy V/VG

Prosecco rosé feels like it's been around forever, but that's not the case. It's only recently producers have been allowed to make it. This is all summer berries, redcurrants, and white flowers. The light yet juicy palate is filled with lively fresh fruits that linger like that last taste of summer.

WHITE WINE

Crisp & Delicate

8. Anciens Temps Blanc, *Vin de France, France*

This Heinz 57 blend brings all sorts of flavours to the wine party; green apples, lychee, fresh cut grass and pithy lemon. Regional French blends can offer some of the best value drinking wines around and this is no exception. Dry, bright and refreshing.

9. Sartori Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie, *Veneto, Italy* V/VG

Fresh almonds and white flowers sit nicely alongside ripe lemon, grapefruit, and blossom fruit. Light and refreshing.

10. Quinta da Lixa Flowers Vinho Verde, *Vinho Verde, Portugal* V/VG

Fruity, Floral and well balanced with notes of White peach, apples and tangerines on the Palate.

11. Roquemolière Picpoul de Pinet Réserve, *Languedoc, France* VG

Vibrant and racy acidity is at the heart of this wine which displays flavours of apples, citrus fruits and a saline minerality. You can taste the Mediterranean seaside all the way through this crisp and refreshing wine.

Elegant & Aromatic

12. Mack & Collie Sauvignon Blanc, *Marlborough, New Zealand*

Fresh herbs sprinkled over passion fruit and melon while lime zest hangs around in the background. This is bright, vibrant and full of energy and demands a second glass.

13. Nicola Bergaglio La Minaia Gavi, *Piemonte, Italy*

A finely crafted, fresh white wine, with a medley of pears, citrus fruits and apples on the nose. The crisp, dry palate will keep you coming back for more.

14. Les Celliers de Cérès Sancerre Le Petit Broux, *Loire, France* V/VG

Good concentration of green fruits and crisp citrus flavours with a racy, mineral streak and refreshingly clean finish. An eminently drinkable Sauvignon.

15. Mar de Frades Albarino, *Rías Baixas, Spain* VG

Pure and focused Albariño with bright lemon, lime zest and grapefruit. The salts of the sea permeate every note of this wine and conjure up images of the Galician coast. A note of almond and warm bread lingers in the background. The palate is light and direct with an almost pétillant freshness. Pure and mineral.

WHITE WINE

Rich & Lush

**16. Les Mougeottes Chardonnay IGP Pays d'Oc,
Languedoc, France V/VG**

Lemon and vanilla on the nose with a round, fruity body and a hint of vanilla oak character. Has more ripeness than a Macon but more savoury character than a New World, making it ideal by the glass.

**17. Not Your Grandma's Riesling,
Eden Valley, Australia V/VG**

Forget the off dry, cloying style that was once popular (back in those bad times before the enlightenment) this is pure, racy and distinctly dry. Fresh limes, lemons and bright green orchard fruits race across the palate being chased by a bright, electric acidity.

**18. Yealands Estate Single Vineyard Pinot Gris,
Marlborough, New Zealand V/VG**

A forward and aromatic nose but with a great background of ripe fruits. Poached pears, red apples, quince, honeydew melon and apricot skin all dance around the nose and palate. There's a note of honey and cinnamon here amongst the bright and refreshing acidity.

**19. Oliver Tricon Chablis 1er Cru,
Burgundy, France V/VG**

Oyster shells, orchard fresh green apples, and a steely salinity comes together to create an ocean of crisp, clean, interwoven flavours. As refreshing as a spring day and just as satisfying.

**20. Ken Forrester FMC Chenin Blanc,
Stellenbosch, South Africa**

Is this the southern hemisphere's greatest Chenin? It's a strong contender, surely. A heady mixture of ripe tropical fruits, supple smokiness and intense marmalade notes. This isn't shy about coming forward and has layer upon layer of complex flavours ranging from a note of lemon curd through apricots to honeyed papaya. A tremendous experience from The Godfather Of Chenin.

**21. Domaine Ferret Pouilly Fuissé,
Burgundy, France V/VG**

Fuissé makes great Burgundy in its own right. Here is a core of lemon, peach and orange surrounded by fine mineral notes, lime zest, red apple and supple smoky vanilla. There's a subtle creaminess to the palate the is dynamic against the pure minerality and citrus lift.

RED WINE

Spicy & Earthy

22. Anciens Temps Rouge, *Vin de France, France*

Classic Vine Rouge brings to mind images of a rustic farmer's table. This wine evokes a simpler time when a lunchtime glass would be filled with summer berries, soft tannins and just a hint of aromatic spice. This medium bodied wine is round and soft, and perfect for whiling away an afternoon.

23. Quinta do Crasto Flor de Crasto Red, *Douro, Portugal* V/VG

A warm and ripe nose of blackcurrant, bramble and plum with subtle earthy spice notes. The palate is medium weight and approachable with pepper, earthiness and a fine seam of vanilla. Fine tannins and a light acidity allow the dark fruits and spice to gently caress the palate on to the long finish.

24. Chateau Ste. Michelle Columbia Valley Syrah, *Washington, USA* V/VG

At its best Syrah is rich and gamy. This has black olive, blackcurrant, bramble and hints of smoked meats. The fruit driven palate is full yet structured and complex with layers of vanilla, pepper spices, black fruits and a touch of earthiness.

Soft & Smooth

25. I Someleri Dolcetto, *Piemonte, Italy*

Bright cherry aromas mix with blackcurrant leaf, plum and damson fruit. The palate has soft, fine tannins with redcurrant, dark cherry and bramble flavours. A subtle hint of spice rounds off the pleasant finish.

26. Louis Tête Beaujolais Villages, *Beaujolais, France* V/VG

Fresh, bright, juicy and expressive on the nose with an equally appealing and accessible palate bursting with pure, elegant red fruit. An easy-drinking, honest and fruit-forward red.

27. Yealands Pinot Noir, *Marlborough, New Zealand* V/VG

There are plenty of Kiwi Pinots that are a little overdone; too heavy on the fruit and oak. This is not one of them and shows just what NZ can do with this noble variety. Fruit stays in the red camp: redcurrants, raspberries and strawberries. The oak is subtle, just hinting at vanilla and chocolate underneath. Mid weight yet elegant, this is a super New World Pinot Noir.

RED WINE

Soft & Smooth

28. Joseph Drouhin Nuits St George, Burgundy, France

A fine and richly fruit led example of one of the great Burgundies. Wild strawberries, cherries and redcurrants sit atop damp forest leaves, mushroom and the faintest hint of savoury smoke. The palate is taut with cleansing acidity and soft, slightly chewy tannins. Here the influence of oak is subtle and nuanced and allows the vibrant red, wild fruits to really sing.

29. Vinamar Merlot, Casablanca Valley, Chile

Is there a better example of pure Merlot than one that comes from Chile? Probably not. Medium bodied with fine, soft tannins and a subtle acidity this wine is filled with black plum, dark cherry and hints of milk chocolate. Juicy, pleasing and eminently drinkable.

Big & Bold

30. Les Mougeottes Cabernet Sauvignon, Languedoc, France

The Languedoc is very much France's new world. Here they produce wines with more open fruit, in this case ripe blackcurrants, black plums and just a hint of pepper. The modern approach continues into the winemaking and this wine shows pure vanilla smoke from the new oak barrels used in its production.

31. El Esteco Cuma Organic Malbec, Salta, Argentina *V/VG*

The nose is lead by fine herbs, minerals, soft plummy fruit, and a distinct note of violets. There's an aromatic lift amongst the savoury feeling fruits. Finely grained tannins melt away gently leaving cherries, plums, blackberries... with just a subtle hint of smoke and sweet spice.

32. Juan Gil Yellow Label Monastrell Valencia, Spain *V/VG*

A ripe nose of vibrant red fruits including strawberries and raspberries surrounded by notes of white pepper and cinnamon. The palate is lively and structured yet with a soft juicy quality. Mineral like acidity supports notes of sweet vanilla, plum fruit and spice.

33. Trapiche Estacion 1883 Cabernet Franc, Mendoza, Argentina *V/VG*

A combination of dark strawberry and cherry fruit mingles with brambles and currants. The lovely savoury note of dark pepper and supple leafiness add complexity and depth. Medium bodied with a refreshing acidity and melt in the mouth tannins. Luscious red and black currant notes.

RED WINE

Big & Bold

**34. Vieux Chateau Brun Pomerol,
Bordeaux, France VG**

Fragrant and perfumed but with a serious depth of earthy fruit. Redcurrants and raspberries sit atop a sweet earthiness, cigar box, sweet tobacco and smoked cedar. A finely structured palate with fine tannins and rich acidity give a natural home to the range of red fruits, oak and spice flavours.

**35. Trapiche Perfiles Malbec Textura Fina,
Mendoza, Argentina**

The nose is led by oak; rich vanilla pod and fresh cedar alongside just a hint of milk chocolate. The fruit is deeply structured and intense. Sweet sandalwood smoke gently lays across black plum, blackberry and bramble. But there something in the core here that remains red fruited. Emerging from the kirsch note that keeps appearing is red cherry and wild raspberry. Something floats around like baked liquorice. Damsons come to the fore only to lead to violets and minerals. The palate is weighty and rich but immediately cool.

**36. Connetable de Talbot,
Bordeaux, France**

Warm and refined black fruits including blackcurrants and blackberries are surrounded by sweet cigar smoke, notes of minerality and a touch of cedar. This is refined and focused Claret with well defined dark fruits and smoothly integrated oak notes. Long and satisfying.

ROSE

Crisp & Dry

**37. Anciens Temps Rosé,
Vin de France, France V/VG**

A light and dry rosé with notes of white flowers, strawberries and cranberries. A refreshing acidity keeps things vibrant and energetic.

**38. La Vidaubanaise Comte de Provence Rosé,
Provence, France**

As dry and crunchy as a dry and crunchy thing. Herbaceous red fruits with a hint of salinity, grapefruit and pomegranate. The very style that Provence is known, and indeed popular, for producing.

Sweet & Fruity

**39. Desert Rose White Zinfandel,
California, USA**

Imagine biting into a strawberry tart that has just a drizzle of sweet cherry syrup and you've got this off dry wonder. Fresh, juicy and with a gentle sugar hit.
